Improperly Disposed HHW Can

Bottom Line



Improper disposal is dangerous to you and your community



It is against the law to throw HHW in the trash, on the ground or down the drain

What Can You Do?

Choose

Choose the least hazardous product

Buy

Buy only what you need and use it up

Reuse

Reuse certain products such as paints

Be a Smart Shopper



Always read the labels



Buy only what you need



Look for alternatives or safer substitutes



If you **MUST** use a hazardous product, buy the least hazardous available and use it safely



Use it up, use less or give usable product to a friend or neighbor

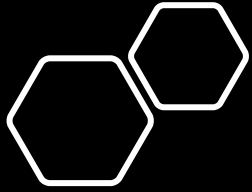
For This	Try This
Silver and Jewelry Cleaner	Toothpaste OR a mix of warm water, baking soda, salt and strip of aluminum foil
All Purpose Cleaner	Warm water, white vinegar and dash of liquid soap
Furniture Polish	Mineral Oil
Spot Remover	Club Soda
Drain Cleaner	Boiling water, baking soda and white vinegar
Air Freshener	Potpourri (Dried Flowers)
Cleanser	Baking Soda
Brass Cleaner	Paste of white vinegar and salt
No-Pest Strips	Fly Swatter
Copper Cleaner	Paste of lemon juice and salt

Store, Package and Dispose of Household Hazardous Waste Properly

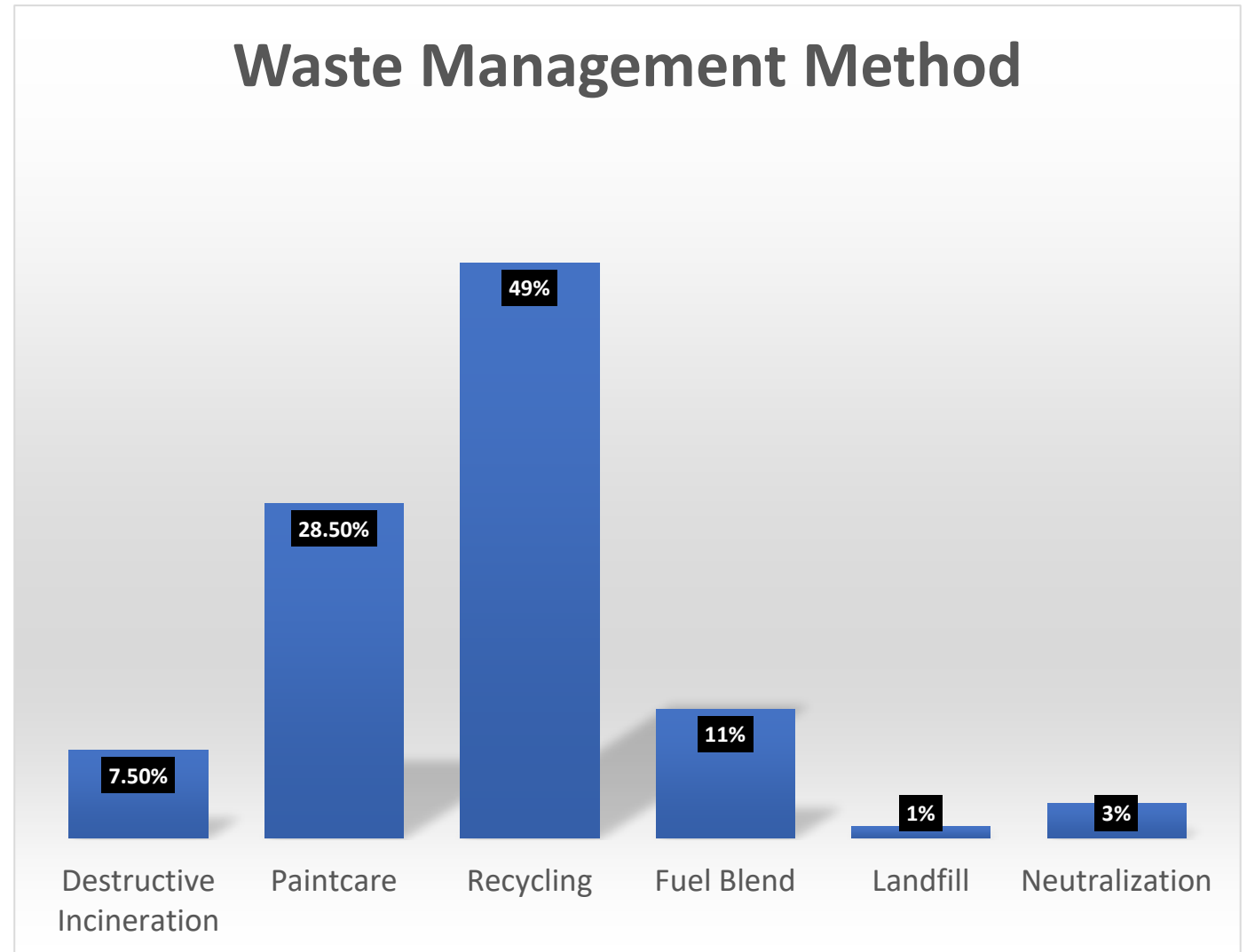
- Store hazardous products away from children and pets

- Package your waste in sturdy boxes and keep in the trunk of your vehicle
- Stay inside your vehicle and wear a mask or face covering
