Introduction & Background

- In 2019, the Novato Sanitary District (NSD) converted from at-large to by-division elections
- NSD now has 5 electoral Divisions for its Board of Directors
- The Board of Directors oversees the redistricting process following the 2020 Census and is responsible for adopting the new division boundaries

What are the mapping criteria?

- Compliance with US and CA Constitution (equal population)
- 2. Compliance with **Federal Voting Rights Act** (race and language minorities)
- 3. Topography
- 4. Geography
- 5. Cohesiveness, contiguity, integrity, and compactness of territory
- 6. Communities of Interest


What is the Ideal Population per division?

Ideal population per divisions =

Total population : # of divisions

- Divisions are equalized with the count of all persons from the decennial census
 - Novato Sanitary District 2020 Population: 56,240
- Ideal population for NSD Divisions?
 - Total Population ÷ five divisions = Ideal population
 - \circ 56,240 ÷ 5 = 11,248 people per division




