ORDINANCE NO. 101

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 70, THE SANITARY CODE OF THE NOVATO SANITARY DISTRICT ADOPTED APRIL 22, 1991

The Board of Directors of Novato Sanitary District of Marin County, California, does ordain as follows:

Section 708(b) of Ordinance No. 70, the Sanitary Code of the Novato Sanitary District, adopted April 22, 1991, shall be, and said section is hereby, amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 708 Connection Charges.

(b) Connection Charge. A connection charge of Six Thousand Thirty Dollars (\$6,030.00) per family unit shall be paid to the District by each person desiring connection to the public sewer. Payment of said connection charge shall be made prior to the issuance of a connection permit and shall be in addition to all other fees and charges required to be paid under District rules and regulations."

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances. The Board hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance or any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase hereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared to be unconstitutional.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Upon adoption this Ordinance shall be entered in full in the minutes of the District Board, shall be published once in the <u>MARIN INDEPENDENT JOURNAL</u>, a daily newspaper of general circulation published in the District, within one (1) week following its passage and adoption, and shall take effect on July 1, 2004.
